4. ISO 44004:2021 - Collaborative business relationship management - Guidelines for large organizations seeking collaboration with micro, small and medium-sized enterprises (MSMEs)
5. ISO/TS 44006:2023 - Collaborative business relationship management - Guidelines for university-business collaboration
6. ISO/TR 44000:2019 - Principles for successful collaborative business relationship management
